Drug & Alcohol Detox Symptoms

Many people delay seeking an addiction treatment center because they are afraid of going through the detox process. An individual who has been drinking or using

drugs heavily for a prolonged period of time, who suddenly stops or dramatically reduces the amount of their intake, may experience intense pain and discomfort, for a short period, during this phase.

Some common symptoms of detox we see at our northern California drug and alcohol detox programs include:

- Sweating
- Shaky Hands
- Anxiety
- Vomiting
- Headaches
- Insomnia
- Disorientation
- Seizures
- Hallucinations

There is no way to determine how severe a person's withdrawal symptoms will be until the process has started. Therefore, it's nearly always beneficial to seek treatment at a detox center.

Can Detox Include Medication-Assisted Treatment?

One of the most common reasons people refuse to seek treatment is they're nervous about the discomfort of the withdrawal symptoms. If you're addicted to opioids or alcohol, the withdrawal symptoms can be particularly intense, particularly if you don't have support at your side. Fortunately, the withdrawal symptoms associated

with these substances can be alleviated using MAT treatment. MAT or medication-assisted treatment is a recovery option that provides patients with FDA-approved medicine to relieve symptoms. Today, the FDA has approved three medications to relieve the symptoms of alcohol withdrawal and opioid withdrawal.

At Summit Estate, one of the medications we use is buprenorphine. Buprenorphine is a partial opioid agonist that binds with your opioid receptors, which reduces the pain and feelings of euphoria.

Buprenorphine isn't a full opioid.

However, it acts like one enough to provide relief from opioid withdrawal.

- Studies show that both buprenorphine and methadone reduce the risk of an overdose from opioids.
- Medications can also assist in decreasing the transmission of blood-borne illnesses, such as HIV because they reduce the risk of risky behaviors like sharing needles.
- Medication-assisted treatment during detox reduces a person's risk of future illicit opioid use.

What To Expect Upon Admission To Our Detox Center

At Summit Estate detox residential center, our Northern California drug and alcohol detox program protocols are designed to alleviate adverse physical effects accompanying withdrawal. Upon admission, each resident meets with one of our highly qualified physician partners in order to design a unique plan for detoxification and recovery. As part of a customized rehabilitation plan, the physician will prescribe medications needed for our clients to be as safe and comfortable as possible during the detox phase. We regularly monitor vitals and self-reported symptoms to determine the efficacy of the detox protocol and to mitigate health risks. At all times, we strive to assist our clients in maintaining optimum comfort throughout this process.



Dual Diagnosis at Our Detox Center

One of the things that our admissions process may determine is that you require dual diagnosis treatment. In many cases, drug and alcohol use is due to a mental health condition. Alternatively, you may experience a mental health issue because of your drug or alcohol use. Dual diagnosis treatment is an option for those who suffer from both addiction and mental health issues. This treatment option addresses both conditions concurrently. We offer

an array of mental health treatment options alongside our detox programs, including <u>depression</u> and <u>anxiety</u>.

Simultaneous treatment of mental health conditions and addiction is vital to an individual's long-term recovery. If you only get treatment for the addiction, you won't have the tools to cope with the uninhibited mental health symptoms. These unabated symptoms often cause people to return to drug or alcohol use in order to get relief. Alternatively, if you choose to continue drinking or using drugs after getting treatment for your mental health condition, your <u>substance use</u> could lead to additional mental health problems. It could also lead to worsening symptoms for the condition you're already battling.

With dual diagnosis treatment that occurs concurrently with detox and the next steps in treatment, you have a much better chance of long-term recovery.


What Happens After Detox

 Residential treatment: If you've suffered from addiction for an extended period of time, residential treatment is crucial to your recovery. During this program,

- you'll stay at our treatment center 24/7. You will receive therapy and ongoing support from our expert staff members.
- Partial hospitalization treatment: A
 partial hospitalization program, or PHP,
 is the next step in treatment. During this
 program, you'll attend treatment each day
 of the week but return home at night.
- Intensive outpatient treatment: Once you've overcome the initial hurdles of sober living outside of our treatment center, you may be ready for our intensive outpatient treatment program. During IOP, you'll attend treatment a few days a week and put your coping mechanisms into practice the rest of the time at home.
- Aftercare programs: Even after leaving treatment, you may feel like you'd benefit from additional support. We offer a range of aftercare programs to help you through life's challenges and stresses.
